 - We received an overwhelming amount of glowing reviews and landed a feature interview with New 12 Reporter Della Crews.


BOARD MEMBER UPDATE


Our Board Member Hebb Abbas decided not to renew her contract to continue to be a board member. She served two years with us and were glad to have her onboard.


